

Data Processing Agreement

IPAY processes personal data in connection with its last-mile payment and release infrastructure. Depending on the relationship and service flow, IPAY may act as a data processor, sub-processor, independent controller or separate controller.

Where IPAY processes personal data on behalf of a merchant, carrier, payment service provider or business partner, the processing is governed by a Data Processing Agreement in accordance with Article 28 GDPR.

Our Data Processing Agreement describes:

- the roles of the parties;
- the subject matter and duration of processing;
- the nature and purpose of processing;
- the categories of personal data and data subjects;
- confidentiality obligations;
- security measures;
- use of sub-processors;
- international transfers;
- assistance with data subject rights;
- breach notification;
- deletion or return of personal data;
- audit and compliance information.

The applicable DPA forms part of the commercial agreement between IPAY and the relevant customer or partner.
